Your tasks

- You will support the Chair of Philosophy (AOS: Philosophy of Technology and Science) in teaching, research and administration.
- You will carry out research in the area of Theoretical Philosophy or Applied Ethics (of Technology, Nature, or the Life Sciences).
- You will publish research findings and participate in national and international conferences.
- You will be involved in teaching at the University to the extent of 2 semester periods per week (preparation and implementation of courses as well as supervision of students' work) in the Bachelor's degree programme in Philosophy, in the Master's degree programme KTW and in the minor subject area.
- You will support the Institute in applying for research projects and organising conferences.

Your Qualifications

- You have a degree (Master's or equivalent; doctoral degree in case of desired habilitation) in Philosophy or Cultural Studies with a philosophical focus with a grade of at least "good".
- You have very good knowledge of one of the two languages German or English and at least good knowledge of the other.
- You bring teaching experience.
- Experience in the fields of Phenomenology, Philosophy of Technology and Natural Philosophy as well as a historical focus are an advantage, but not a requirement.
- You are flexible, can perform under pressure and work well in a team.
- You are aiming for further scientific qualification.
