2nd Berlin-Hamburg Workshop in Early Modern Philosophy (HU-UHH)

Hamburg University, **June 28-29, 2019**

Submission deadline: **February 28, 2019**

We invite abstracts of no more than **350 words** on any topic in early modern philosophy (construed, roughly, as the period from Montaigne to Reid) for a workshop co-organized by the philosophy departments of Humboldt University Berlin and Hamburg University (HU-UHH). The workshop aims to bring together established scholars, junior faculty, and advanced graduate students, and will take place at Hamburg University on **June 28 and 29, 2019**. The language of presentation and discussion is English. Talks should be 35-40 minutes, followed by 30-35 minutes of discussion. **Deadline** for abstract submissions is **February 28, 2019**; decisions will be made by April 15, 2019. Please submit documents in PDF format to hu.uhh.earlymodern@gmail.com. The abstract should be prepared for blind review (please provide your name, contact details, and institutional affiliation in a separate document). Confirmed keynote speakers are Marleen Rozemond (University of Toronto) and Falk Wunderlich (Universität Halle). Successful applicants may have the opportunity to apply for a travel fund of 300 EUR to cover (at least parts) of their travel costs. Details of the program will be available in April.
