

CALL FOR PAPERS

10th MULTILATERAL KANT COLLOQUIUM: *The Space of Feelings: Kant and His Legacy* Parma and Ferrara (Italy), 28-31 August 2023

The University of Ferrara and the University of Parma, in collaboration with the KANTINSA-Project, the FINO-PhD Programme, the Società Italiana di Studi Kantiani (Italian Society for Kant Studies), and the Kant-Gesellschaft, invite submissions for the 10th Multilateral Kant Colloquium, scheduled to take place in Parma and Ferrara (Italy) on 28-31 August 2023.

The colloquium is entitled: *The Space of Feelings: Kant and His Legacy*. Whilst the focus of the symposium is on the role played by the concept of feeling(s) in the context of Kant's philosophy and its reception, papers may also be accepted on other aspects of Kant's philosophy and its legacy – from Kant's time to the present.

The Multilateral Colloquium is planned to involve approximately 70 participants – around 15 of whom will be invited speakers. Accepted presentations cannot exceed 20 minutes, and will be followed by 10 minutes of Q&A. The official languages of the symposium are Italian, English, and German. However, participants can choose to present their papers in Spanish, Portuguese, or French, provided that a translation in one of the official languages is available during the presentation. In light of the multilateral dimension of the Kant colloquium and its origin, the selection committee particularly welcome papers from participants working in South America, Portugal, Spain, and Italy.

The selection committee is composed of an international group of scholars and is chaired by the organisers, Faustino Fabbianelli (Parma) and Antonino Falduto (Ferrara).

In order to be evaluated, submissions must contain (a) a title and (b) a longer abstract (max. 1,000 words, including footnotes and references – submissions longer than this will not be considered) and should be prepared for blind review. Please include the word count at the end of the paper and send your submission in PDF format. Contact information should also be included in the mail.

The deadline for submissions is the **30th of December 2022**. Notices of acceptance will be issued by the **6th of February 2023**.
